The Church Council met last Monday (the 13th). Here's what was discussed:

Reverend Briones will be attending a UCC sponsored development program for ministers the first Sunday in June. The program is entitled "Next Generation Leadership Initiative." We are fortunate that Reverend Briones will be able to benefit from this experience.

It looks like we will be partnering with Edina Morningside/Linden Hills to conduct/offer a Vacation Bible School experience in late August. We'll keep you posted.

We are taking a fresh look at our Outreach programs and are considering how to better focus our efforts. We are likely to increase our emphasis on food support programs and our partnerships with VEAP. We'll be continuing this discussion at our next meeting.

We will also be revisiting our Enduring Fund Policies and Procedures. It's been close to 20 years since we've conducted such a review. Any significant changes will be brought to the congregation for a vote.

Pentecost Sunday

Strengthen the Church Offering • Mental Health Sunday

Acts 2:1-4 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

It's especially poignant to receive the Strengthen the Church offering on Pentecost, the day in which God's presence as wind and fire was heard, felt and seen by all those gathered. As winds of the Spirit sweept over the waters in Genesis beginning Creation, the winds of Spirit sweep over people creating community anew.

On this day, we remember that we are co-creators with God of the reign which is to come. Pentecost reminds us that we are never alone in this co-creation. Both those within our church walls and those without can be vessels of the Holy Spirit, and when we speak, we will be heard and understood. And the promise of Pentecost is that the Holy Spirit does not just fill us with words, but also incites us into action on behalf of the divine.
